

How to Download and Print Documents

Step 1: Choose Your Document

Browse through our document library above and click on any document card that interests you. Each document contains valuable information for seniors and their families.

Tip: Look for the document icons and titles to find what you need - Medicare guides, fraud prevention, Social Security information, and more.

Step 2: Download the PDF When you click on a document card, you'll see options to either "Download PDF" or "View Online". For printing, choose "Download PDF".

- Click the "Download PDF" button
- Your browser will download the file to your Downloads folder
- The file will be saved with a clear, descriptive name

Note: If you're not sure where your downloads go, check your browser's download history or look in your computer's Downloads folder.

Step 3: Open and Print

Once downloaded, you can open and print your document:

- Double-click the downloaded PDF file to open it
- Press **Ctrl+P** (Windows) or **Cmd+P** (Mac) to print
- Or click "File" → "Print" in your PDF viewer
- Choose your printer and print settings
- Click "Print" to start printing

Step 4: Share and Advocate

Now that you have your printed documents:

- Share copies with family members and caregivers
- Take them to appointments with healthcare providers
- Use them to advocate for senior rights in your community

- Keep copies in an organized file for easy reference
